

- Mount the radio to the DDIN Brackets with the screws supplied with the unit. (Figure A)

Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation.


- **3.** Mount the radio/bracket assembly into the dash. (Figure B)




- Unsnap and remove trim from around top center to passenger side dash. (Figure A)

- **4.** Remove two screws from the driver's side vent trim and remove. (Figure D)






- **5.** Remove five screws from instrument cluster and remove. (Figure E)

- 8. Remove four screws securing the factory radio chassis and remove it. (Figure H)






